But I live here in Lancaster and am happy to say that the best teacher I ever had teaches in Lancaster. I have taken lessons for years and find Tom (Doriski) to be able to figure out how to overcome any difficulty I am having with my "moves". I have seen him work to integrate first time beginners into group lessons attended by more experienced dancers with everyone learning and benefiting from the lesson. Really!
